

Council Proceedings
August 23, 2010

The Marshalltown City Council met in regular session on August 23, 2010, at 5:30 PM in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Beach called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. ROLL CALL: Present –Grabenbauer, Hoop, Lamer, Schubert, with Wirin present electronically on the speakerphone. Absent: Maxwell and Wenner. Bob Schubert reminded the public school begins August 24 and asked the public to watch for kids. City Administrator Randy Wetmore advised the council of street improvements planned for this fiscal year, including Woodland Street and micropaving portions of Main and State Streets. Asphalt work should start on Center Street by the end of the week.

Schubert moved to approve the agenda, second by Grabenbauer. Motion approved 5-0.

Consent agenda adopted 5-0.

The council briefly discussed zoning's nonconforming property issue. There was no motion to require a formal application and fee be submitted to staff in order to consider the request. Schubert moved to waive the \$500 application fee. There was no second. Motion died.

Schubert moved to adopt Resolution 2010-135 Resolution Approving A Contract For Police Traffic Services Between The City Of Marshalltown, Iowa, And Department Of Public Safety, Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau Created Pursuant To Chapter 28E.12 Of The Iowa Code, 10/1/2010-9/30/2011, second by Grabenbauer. Resolution adopted 5-0.

Lamer moved to adopt Resolution 2010-136 Approving A Contract For Tobacco Enforcement Services Between The City Of Marshalltown, Iowa, And The Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division, State Of Iowa, Created Pursuant To Chapter 28E.12 Of The Iowa Code, 10/1/2010-3/31/2011, second by Grabenbauer. Resolution adopted 5-0.

ORDINANCES:

Schubert moved to approve the third reading and adopt Ordinance 14878 to Amend Number of Handicap Parking Spaces, thirty minute and three hour parking near the City Hall Complex and Veterans Memorial Coliseum, second by Grabenbauer. Ordinance adopted 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Parks Director Terry Gray reviewed the remaining Parks budget from the JBS Swift purchase of French Park. Al Hoop inquired about the damaged campground entrance to the park.
