The Band

Let me tell you a little about myself and the Municipal Band. My name is Paul Sibbel and I am one of five band directors with the Marshalltown Community School District and the West Marshall Community School District. I was asked to direct the Marshalltown Municipal Band after Charles Bogner retired from the position following the conclusion of the 2008 season. I am honored and humbled to be a part of this great tradition. The Marshalltown Municipal Band was established in 1887 as the Iowa Soldier's Home band and renamed in 1933. We play on the courthouse lawn downtown on Thursday evenings during the summer months, on Memorial Day and on Veterans Day. We have a dress code of khaki bottoms (skirt/slacks) and our Municipal Band Polo.

Business Stuff

If you are a returning member, we need to double check your status as far as W-4/I-9 forms are concerned.
