**TERRACE TREES** – Trees on the terrace area (city right-of-way) are the responsibility of the property owner. Trees, including terrace trees and those on private property must be trimmed to 8’ above the sidewalk and 15’ above the street. No trees may be planted on the terrace area without a permit. The permit, as well as a brochure outlining the rules and prohibited species, is available at the Parks and Recreation office or online. Removal of trees can only be done by the City. Terrace trees that appear dead or diseased should be reported to the Parks and Recreation Department.
